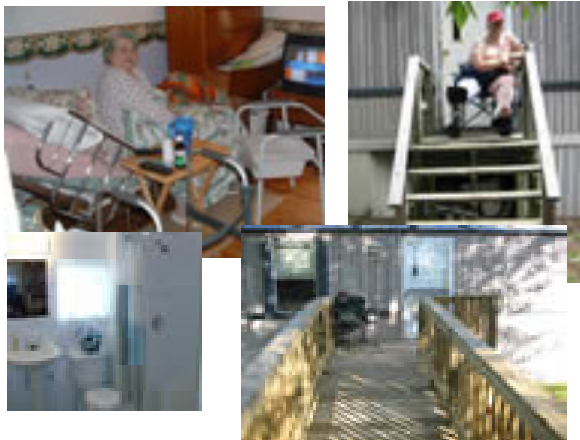
Who We Serve:

Elderly, disabled, and low-income citizens in Clarke, Warren, Shenandoah, and Frederick Counties, and Winchester City

- An elderly woman, living on a fixed income, worries about her leaking roof. The leak has now penetrated the ceiling and walls in her home, and she must use pans to catch the water. How will she pay for a new roof on her social security income of just \$6,000 a year?
- It is January and an elderly man gets out of bed to discover a very cold house. His income is only \$8,500 a year and he now has to replace his furnace. How will he stay warm for the winter?
- A young couple with 4 children are both working, but struggling to give their children food, clothing, and shelter, on an income of \$20,000 a year. Their well-pump has quit working and in order to have water they must replace it. How will they replace their old well-pump.

These are real examples of stories that take place everyday in our community. Help with Housing works to provide happy endings to stories like these.

A great deal of our money comes from grants that are “matching grants”. They will only give us an amount equal to what we can raise from the community. Every dollar that you give can be doubled by a matching grant.
